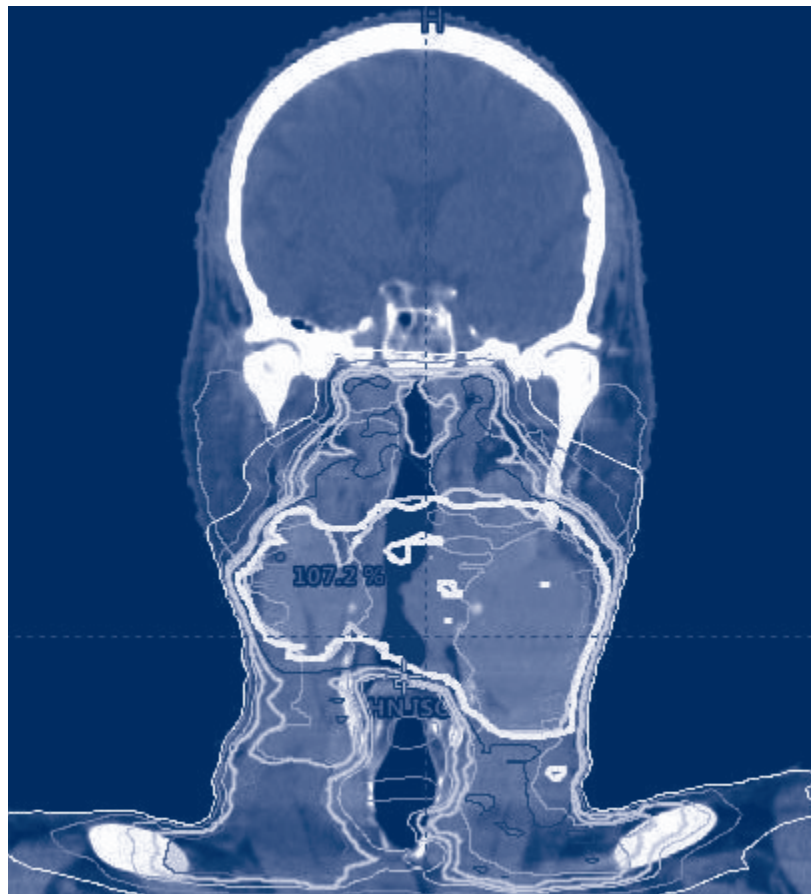


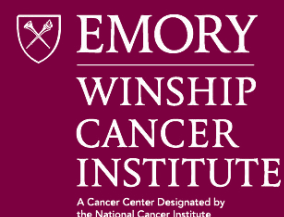

GENERAL INFORMATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This live symposium will explore the current treatment paradigms for the multi-disciplinary treatment of Head and Neck Cancer (HNCA). Recent data on this topic will be covered to apprise the audience of these rapidly evolving findings, and expert faculty will instruct participants on the optimal application of these data through a series of panel discussions and case presentations.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This activity is intended for medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, surgical oncologists, dentists and other healthcare professionals who provide medical care for patients with head and neck cancer.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this educational activity, participants should be able to:

- Select optimal therapy for locally advanced HNCA based on current recommendations and recent evidence.
- Employ recent data and current treatment guidelines in the management of premalignant oral lesions.
- Apply best practices when integrating radiotherapy in the management of patients with HNCA.
- Incorporate recent data from trials evaluating immunology in the management of HPV-positive oropharyngeal cancer.
- Integrate robotic surgery in treatment plans for eligible patients with oropharyngeal cancer.
- Employ current treatment guidelines and best practices in the rehabilitation of patients with HNCA receiving chemoradiation.
- Describe the emerging role of proton therapy and identify which patients may benefit from this technology.

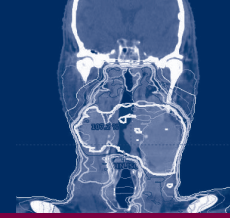
