“Community-Based Assessments of Soil Contamination and Childhood Exposure to Heavy Metals in Atlanta Urban Agriculture”

This pilot measured levels of heavy metal soil contamination in urban gardens and farms and investigated how consumption of contaminated soils or vegetables grown in these soils could affect health.

This pilot linked state-of-the-art exposure information from ambient traffic-related PM2.5 modeling with extensive clinical measurements and metabolomics data gathered on cohort members.
